Be a good Berean!

- Research the information on this website! Make sure it agrees with the Bible.
- Acts 17:11, Now the Berean Jews were of more noble character than those in Thessalonica, for they received the message with great eagerness and examined the Scriptures every day to see if what Paul said was true.

Believe the Bible

- Take the Bible seriously.
- Read the Bible daily.
- Pray daily.
- Get an Audio Bible. Audio Bibles are a great way to calm your environment. Evil spirit don't enjoy listening to Gods word. If you have a house of chaos or have trouble with depression, have the audio Bible run softly all the time.

Speak out loud

- It forges you're authority in Christ.
- Pray out loud.
- You are declaring who you are.
- Your stomach will tell you the state of your heart. When you forgive someone, then say "I Bless them!" If you stomach knots up, then say it over and over until you stomach is calm.
- Speak the promises of God back to him.

How to respond to God

- Two arrows. 2 Kings 13:15
 - Whole hearted. Mark 12:30
 - Moses first conversation. Exodus 3:11
 - David's dancing. 2 Samuel 6:14
 - Being a child. Matthew 18
- What we see in all these stories is how to and how not to respond to God. Respond in confidence that God will see you through the situation. Be whole hearted and excited, even if you are scared to death. Know that God will push your tolerances.

John 11:44

44 And the dead man came, his hands and feet were bound in grave clothes, his face wrapped in a head cloth. Jesus told them, “Unwrap him and let him go!”

**Jesus resurrects the body but he doesn't unwrap the body. Spiritually
Jesus brings us from death to life but how do we unwrap each other
from our burial clothes?**



The picture shows that we are tied together through sin, soul ties, oaths, unforgiveness, generational sins and resentment. Go through each one of these, by asking God to reveal things you need to repent of and who do you need to forgive. God will give you mental pictures of people and events in your life that need to be addressed.

For resentment, close your eyes and imagine yourself handing off situations and events. Say out loud “Lord I give you this situation. I don’t know what to do with this, but I will no longer live under the burden of it and I trust that you know what to do with it.”

Buttoning up the ship

- Read through a Door Closing Prayer.
- Breaking Ungodly Soul ties. In the Library, I have a sheet on breaking soul ties. Plus there are countless videos on the subject. Take your time and be thorough.
- Invite the Holy Spirit into everything in your life. Your family life, work life, friendships, struggles, addictions and your hidden dark places.
- Don't be surprised if you are tempted after going through the door closing prayer. Evil spirits know what they are doing and they instantly start repairing all the chains you just broke.
- Evil spirits go through three common steps with humans. 1. We don't exist. 2. We will intimidate you. 3. Let's make a deal or peace accord. Don't make a deal! You have all power over them through Jesus Christ. Luke 10:19

Test all Spirits

- 1 Corinthians 12:3 I want you to know that no one speaking by the Spirit of God will curse Jesus and no one can say JESUS IS LORD except the Holy Spirit.
- Say “I rebuke all spirits that will not kneel before Jesus!”
- Rebuking is a way to verbally put a wall between you and a word or idea that you don’t believe in.

Vows and Self Curses

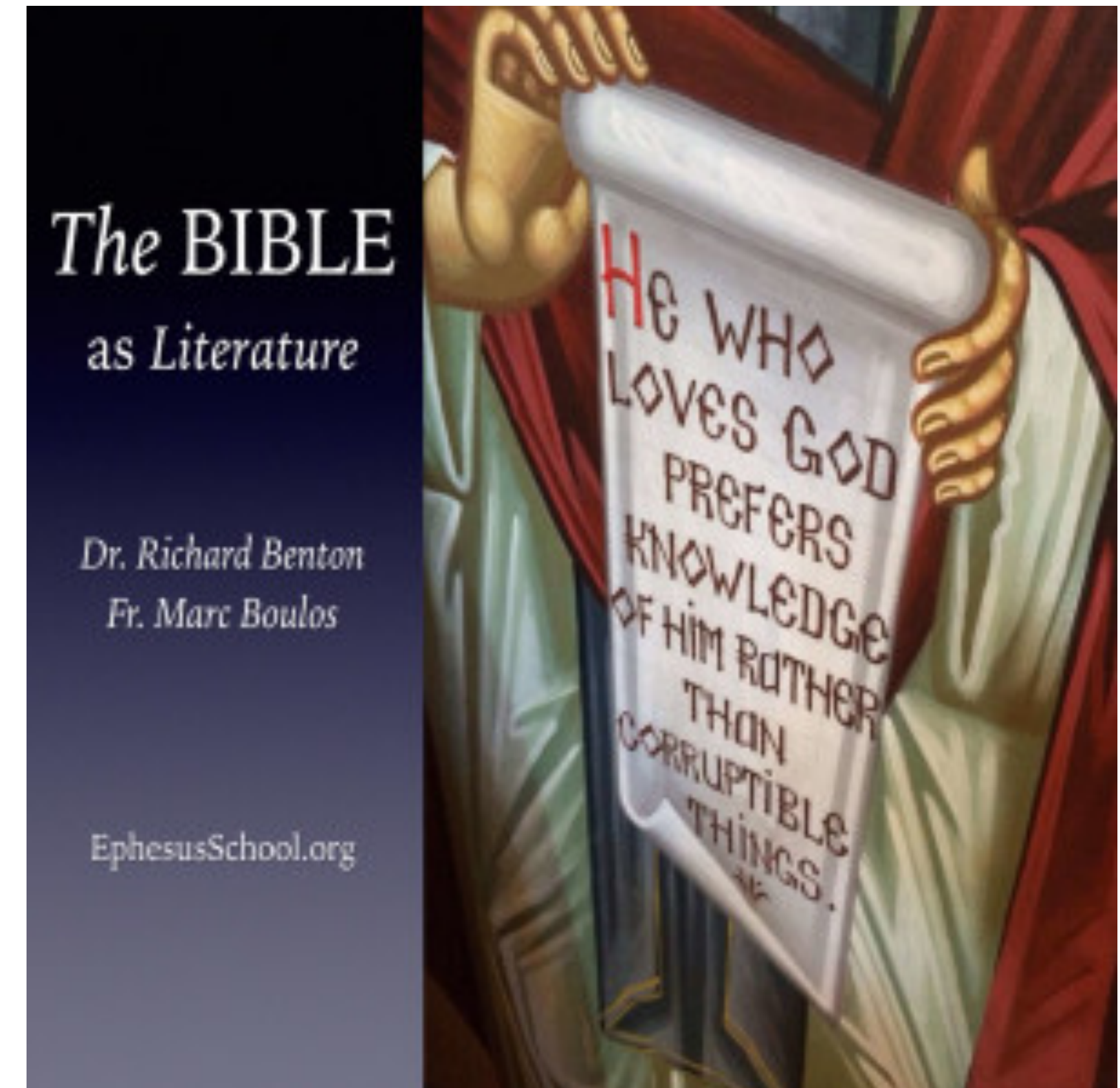
- Don't vow! Let your yes be yes and your no be no. Matthew 5:33-37 ³³“Again you have heard that it was said to those of ^[a]old, ‘You shall not swear falsely, but shall perform your oaths to the Lord.’ ³⁴But I say to you, do not swear at all: neither by heaven, for it is God's throne; ³⁵nor by the earth, for it is His footstool; nor by Jerusalem, for it is the city of the great King. ³⁶Nor shall you swear by your head, because you cannot make one hair white or black. ³⁷But let ^[a]your ‘Yes’ be ‘Yes,’ and your ‘No,’ ‘No.’ For whatever is more than these is from the evil one.
- Don't say things like “I'm so stupid! or “My knees are so jacked up!” or “I am sick”. We give things power through our agreeing with them.
- Read Judges chapters 11&12 The life of Jephateah.

Prayer Language

- It took me four or five times through this video before I received it. Have patience.
- Practice your Prayer Language daily
